## **TOURNAMENT RULES**

- 1. The 6<sup>TH</sup> Annual Greater Richmond USBC Senior Tournament is open to all adult members of the Greater Richmond USBC who have reached the age of 50 years as of FEBRUARY 17, 2024 (born prior to FEBRUARY 17, 1974, BIRTHDATE MUST BE SHOWN). All bowlers must be current members of the GRUSBC for the 2023-2024 season.
- 2. The tournament shall consist of team, doubles and singles events. There shall also be all events handicap and scratch with the first team score counting toward all events. Handicap will be based on 90% of 230. Doubles may consist of 2 women, 2 men or mixed. Team may consist of any combination of men and/or women. Singles and Doubles consists of 6 games (games 1,2,3 singles and games 4,5,6 doubles).
- 3. This will be a two-division tournament based on averages in Singles and All Events.

- 4. Entering averages will be the (a) highest average from 2022-23 winter season. If no (a), then (b) highest 21-game average as of December 31, 2023. If no (a) or (b), then (c) highest 2022-23 summer season. Bowler having none of these averages will use a 21-game average as of squad time provided (PROOF must be provided at the time of bowling). All others bowl scratch. IF NO PROOF PROVIDED, BOWLER WILL BOWL SCRATCH. (ONLY GRUSBC AVERAGES WILL BE ACCEPTED). USBC rule 319(a)2, 20-pin rule does apply as of December 31, 2023. It is each bowler's responsibility to verify and report their averages correctly or it may result in disqualification and scores of zero (0) entered for all frames bowled in all games.
- 5. Proper bowling attire must be worn during the tournament. Midriffs or pants that fall below the hips are not allowed. All shirts must have sleeves.
- 6. The order in which bowlers are listed for the team & doubles events on the entry form will be the order in which they bowl. There will be no change in the order of bowling once the tournament director has accepted the entry.
- 7. Substitutes will be permitted in any event and must be reported to the tournament office prior to the scheduled shift. Substitutes are permitted only in the same lineup position. Once a substitute begins bowling, the substitute will bowl the complete set. If a substitute is not used, the absent bowler receives zero (0) for all frames missed. Refunds will not be given for bowlers arriving late for scheduled shifts.
- 8. Awards will be given on at least a ratio of 1 in 10 per division. USBC rules 319a (2) and 319d (1) do not apply.
- 9. Once submitted and accepted, entry fees are not refundable. RETURNED CHECK FEES ARE \$25.00 PLUS BANK FEES. ENTRY FEE CHECKS SHOULD BE MADE PAYABLE TO GRUSBC.
- 10. Bowlers may compete only one time in doubles & singles, however the bowler may substitute in the doubles event. The first time a bowler competes in an event will count toward the all-events total. All events consist of team, doubles and singles scratch or handicap. To enter all events scratch, the bowler must enter all events handicap. Singles and doubles will be bowled on Saturday and team on Sunday. Multiple entry is allowed in Team, however, no more than 3 bowlers can place together on the prize list.
- 11. Bowlers will remain in their assigned bowling area during tournament play. Failure to be up and ready to bowl could result in a score of zero (0) for that frame. Repeated violations could result in disqualification in the event with a score of zero (0) for frames missed.
- 12. Premature termination of the tournament brought on by war, national emergency or emergency causes relating from fire, national disaster, or any other reason beyond the control of the GRUSBC, shall cause prizes to be awarded to the number of entrants who have participated until that time.
- 13. Confirmations will be sent out after closing date.
