## YOUTH ADULT TOURNAMENT RULES

1. The $14^{\text {th }}$ Annual Greater Richmond USBC Youth Adult Scholarship Tournament is open to all youth members in good standing and a member of a Greater Richmond USBC youth league. This tournament is certified by USBC. All certified adults must be current members of the GRUSBC for the 2023-2024 season.
2. The tournament shall consist of a two-bowler team consisting of one (1) adult and one (1) youth. Handicap is based on $90 \%$ of 230 . There will be no pee-wee division in this event.
3. This will be a five-division tournament based on youth averages as of December 31, 2023. Standings will be based on the average of the youth bowler.

4. Entering averages for youth bowlers will be the highest average as of $12 / 31 / 23$ with 12 games minimum in a GRUSBC youth certified league. Youth not having a 12 -game average as of $12 / 31 / 23$ will use their highest average ( 12 games minimum) on the day they bowl in the tournament. Youth without a 12-game average will bowl scratch. Averages will be verified with a current league standing sheet or mid-year average form. Entering averages for adults will be their highest 21-game GRUSBC average from the 20222023 season or 21 games as of December 31, 2023. If no 2022-2023 average, the bowler is responsible to show proof of average at the time of bowling or will bowl scratch (230). Adults in the uncertified division will be assigned an average of 160 for males and 130 for females unless they have a verifiable previous average which will be assigned at the Tournament Manager's discretion.
5. Proper bowling attire must be worn during the tournament. Midriffs or pants that fall below the hips are not allowed. No hats or electronic devices allowed in the bowling area. All shirts must have sleeves.
6. The adult bowler must be listed first and the youth bowler must be listed second on the entry form.
7. Awards will be given on at least a ratio of 1 in 10 per division. Scholarships will be awarded in all divisions and deposited with the USBC SMART program in the youth bowler's name.
8. Once submitted and accepted, entry fees are not refundable. Returned check fees are $\$ 25.00$ plus any applicable bank fees. Checks must be made payable to GRUSBC.
9. All entries must be verified and signed by the coach unless submitted at check-in.
10. Bowlers will remain in their assigned bowling area during tournament play. Failure to be up and ready to bowl could result in a score of zero ( 0 ) for that frame. Repeated violations could result in disqualification in the event with a score of zero (0) for frames missed.
11. Premature termination of the tournament by any means beyond the control of GRUSBC will cause the proration of all prize monies to the number of entries in each event participating up to the time of termination.
